

**APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION  
AS A REGISTERED CONSUMER**under the *Motor Fuel Tax Act***General Instructions:**

Complete this form if you wish to be appointed a registered consumer under the *Motor Fuel Tax Act*. Registered consumers are businesses, such as international airlines and interjurisdictional railways that are authorized to purchase specific types of fuel without paying the motor fuel tax at the time of purchase. **Step 1**

**Answer all questions in the attached application form.** Your application will be delayed or returned if you do not provide all required information.

**Step 2**

**You may submit your application using one of the following methods:**

Please remember to include, if required:

- your most recent audited financial statements, and
- a signed copy of the form, *Authorization or Cancellation of a Representative (FIN 151)*, if you wish to appoint any additional business contacts.

**Step 3**

**The ministry will, on receiving a complete application:**

- review the application to determine if you meet the requirements for a registered consumer appointment,
- contact you to clarify the application or request additional information, if necessary, or
- inform you by mail, if you are not eligible or your application is not approved.

**Step 4**

**If your application is conditionally approved:**

- two copies of an agreement outlining the duties and conditions of the registered consumer appointment will be sent to you,
- you may be required to submit an unconditional letter of credit from a recognized Canadian financial institution, and
- if you agree with the duties and conditions, you must sign and return both copies of the agreement and the unconditional letter of credit, if applicable, to the ministry. The Director *Motor Fuel Tax Act* will sign and return one copy of the agreement to you and issue a registered consumer certificate.

**Step 5**

You will receive your signed registered consumer agreement and certificate back from the ministry and, effective the date of the agreement, will be required to comply with all of the duties and responsibilities of a registered consumer.

## Instructions for Completing the Application for Registration as a Registered Consumer

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### Item 1

If your business is incorporated under the British Columbia *Business Corporations Act* or other similar legislation, enter the name as it appears on the incorporation certificate and include your incorporation certificate number. If your business is not incorporated in BC, please provide a copy of your certificate of incorporation.

If the business is a partnership, list the full legal names of all partners. If there are more than two partners, attach an additional page.

If the business is not a corporation or a partnership, please describe the type of ownership of the business.

Please include your Federal Business Number which is a unique 9-digit number provided by the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) to identify your business to various government agencies.

### Item 2

The name under which the business will operate (if different than item 1 above).

### Item 3

The physical location of the business (may be different than the mailing address).

### Item 4

The mailing address where tax returns and any correspondence should be sent (if different than item 3 above).

### Item 5

The name of the primary business contact, including telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. This may be your bookkeeper, accountant or an employee. If you wish to appoint a second business contact or change a business contact, please complete and attach the form *Authorization or Cancellation of a Representative (FIN 151)*.

### Item 6

Describe the primary nature of your business. To qualify for registration, your business must be either:

- a commercial air service where all of the scheduled flights that originate or end in BC do **not** include flights between two locations in BC or connect a location in BC with any other location in Canada, or
- a commercial railway that operates in two or more jurisdictions.

### Item 7

Enter the date the business will start or started using fuel for registered consumer activities.

### Item 8

Provide a general description of your business assets (e.g. land, equipment, vehicles), within BC and the approximate value of each asset. Attach a separate sheet if necessary.

### Item 9

The name and address of your principal financial institution.

### Item 10

Provide a copy of your business's most recent audited financial statements if you purchase or use annually in BC more than 20 million litres of a liquid fuel.

### Item 11

Complete the table on page 4 as follows (specify volumes in litres).

- Specify the specific fuel types you want to be included in your Registered Consumer Certificate.
- If you import fuel into BC, describe the annual volume of each fuel type imported into the province.
- If you transfer fuel in BC, describe the annual volume of each fuel type transferred into the supply tank or supplemental supply tank of an aircraft or locomotive.
- If you purchase fuel in BC, describe the annual volume of each fuel type purchased in the province.
- If you are an air service, indicate the annual volume of jet fuel used for international flights.
- If you are a railway, indicate the annual volume of locomotive fuel used for interjurisdictional travel and travel in BC.
- If you export fuel for use outside BC, describe the annual volume of each fuel type exported from the province.

### Item 12

If you are a commercial air service, provide a detailed list of your international flights that begin or end in BC. Also, provide a list of any regular and seasonal flights which connect two locations in the province or connect a BC location with another location in Canada.

If you are a commercial railway, provide a detailed list of rail services you offer in two or more jurisdictions.

### Item 13

All applications must be certified by an authorized signing authority.
