

BUSINESSES IMPACTED BY FLOODING

Businesses directly impacted by flooding, that are unable to file their provincial tax return(s) by the required due date, must submit a written request for a waiver of the interest and penalty resulting from the late return. The submission must include their location and the flood related circumstances that prevented them from filing on time. Requests should be mailed or emailed to the addresses noted below and marked as a flood related letter of request.

To facilitate the provincial tax filing requirements, businesses have been able to file and pay their Manitoba tax accounts online using electronic pre-authorized payments since September 2007.

Effective May 1, 2011, Manitoba's online service has been expanded to enable businesses to make payments through their own financial institution's online bill payment system. Please visit <u>manitoba.ca/TAXcess</u> for more information.
