## NOTICE TO BUSINESSES IMPACTED BY FLOODING

Businesses directly impacted by recent flooding in Saskatchewan that are unable to file their provincial sales tax return(s) by the due date may submit a written request for relief from penalty and interest charges on the return(s) affected. The written submission should include the business location and details of the flood-related circumstances that prevented the return(s) from being filed on time.

The easiest and quickest way to file most provincial tax returns is to use the Saskatchewan Electronic Tax Service (SETS) located at <a href="www.finance.gov.sk.ca/taxes/efile/">www.finance.gov.sk.ca/taxes/efile/</a> and send payment using Internet Banking.
