

BUSINESSES IMPACTED BY FLOODING

Businesses directly impacted by flooding, that are unable to file their retail sales tax returns or any other tax returns for taxes administered by Taxation Division, by the required due date, can request a waiver of the interest and penalty resulting from the late return.

Requests must be in writing and include the following information: the business name, account number, return(s) the request is for, the affected business location, and a description of the circumstances that prevented them from filing their return on time. Requests should be mailed or emailed to the addresses noted below and marked as a flood related request.

Please note that businesses can file and pay their Manitoba tax accounts online using the Taxation Division's service available at <u>manitoba.ca/TAXcess</u>.
